A1. ENROLLMENT

I'm going to take you through the process of enrolling in the THRIVE East of the River program. This program will provide cash and other supports through one of these DC nonprofits: Bread for the City, Building Bridges Across the River (11th Street Bridge Park/THEARC), Far Southeast Family Strengthening Collaborative, and Martha's Table. This project is being sponsored by a consortium of funders, including the Clark Family Foundation, the Diane & Norman Bernstein Foundation, and the Meyer Foundation.

A2. THRIVE East of the River would like to improve its model of providing community support and share what it learns with others, so they are partnering with the Urban Institute (a nonprofit research organization based in DC) to conduct an evaluation. The evaluation will consist of two to three surveys and one or two interviews over the course of the year. For today, we are only asking if you want to complete the first survey. You can decide later if you'd like to complete additional surveys and/or interviews. Your participation in the study is completely voluntary and will NOT affect your enrollment and participation in THRIVE. The Urban Institute believes there is minimal risk to you participating in the evaluation. Your responses will be kept confidential, and none of your responses will be attached to your name. A potential benefit of participating is that your responses could help nonprofits improve program models and better support families like yours during times of crisis.

If you don't give consent to share your information with the Urban Institute, I will still enroll you in THRIVE. If you do consent to share your information with the Urban Institute, we will proceed with filling out the enrollment form first and then completing a brief survey. The Urban Institute will ensure that the information you share is protected—meaning only the Urban research team will be able to see your individual answers and they have pledge to share only group data, so you will not be identifiable in reports on results.
